FEE DISTRIBUTION - Student fees are distributed as listed below

ACTIVITY FEE – This fee covers activities and services for students. Examples of some of the items funded by the activity fee include recreational sports programs, periodic entertainment, the Daily Eastern News and other publications, campus shuttle service, and student computer labs.

ATHLETIC FEE – This fee partially funds men's and women's intercollegiate sports.

HEALTH SERVICE FEE – This fee funds the operations of the Student Health Service and Pharmacy TEXTBOOK RENTAL FEE – This fee covers the rental of textbooks. The rental system represents a significant cost savings for students as opposed to purchasing books. Students have the option to purchase textbooks if they desire. The fee is assessed to both on campus and continuing education classes.

GRANT IN AIDS/SEDS FEE— This fee funds grant and scholarship programs used to attract outstanding students in various fields, thereby benefiting the entire student body.

UNION/BOND REVENUE FEE – This fee funds the operation of the University Union, Lantz Gymnasium, football stadium, and the Campus Recreation Center.

LEGAL FEE – This fee pays for legal advice for full-time students related to off-campus housing and limited representation on misdemeanors and municipal ordinance violations.

COMPUTER NETWORK FEE – This fee funds the cost of the replacement of the total campus network infrastructure, including equipment and lines.

STUDENT INSURANCE FEE – This fee provides a plan of medical insurance coverage to students enrolled in 9 or more on campus hours. This is the only optional fee. To opt out of the plan and waive the fee, contact the Student Insurance Office by 10th class day fall or spring terms, or 5th class day summer term.

CAMPUS IMPROVEMENT FEE – This fee funds renovations and repairs to sidewalks and some campus buildings.

CONTINUING EDUCATION FEE – This fee supports the delivery of instruction for courses administered through Continuing Education. The fee is assessed in place of some campus program and service fees.
