## TOTAL MAJOR COURSEWORK: 125-130 HRS

- Students with two years of the same foreign language and a C average in high school are exempt and can take free electives. Students who have not met this requirement need two semesters of the same foreign language to graduate.
- REC 3550 - Fieldwork must be completed before taking REC 4274 - Internship. Students must complete these field experiences at separate agencies/locations.
- All Recreation Administration required courses must be completed prior to REC 4275 - Internship.
- REC 4725 - Internship must be completed in a clinical, residential or community-based therapeutic program under the supervision of a Certified Therapeutic Specialist (CTRS) by the National Council for Therapeutic Recreation Certification.
- \*\*\*In order to seek certification by the National Council for Therapeutic Recreation Certification (NCTRC), the student must select courses from at least three of the following six areas: adaptive physical education, biological/physical sciences, human services, psychology, sociology, or special education.
- REC 4710 - Therapeutic Recreation Seminar is a capstone class that must be taken during a student's senior year.
- EIU Senior Seminar must be taken outside major.
