


Once the report has run, click on your majors in the window on the left side of the screen (you may need to double-click the first time). **Be careful when you print so you do not print the entire document.** To print a range of pages, right click on the report page, select **Print**, click the **Pages** radio button, enter the page numbers that you want to print, and click **Print**. To print each page as you view it, right click on the report page, select **Print**, click the **Current Page** radio button, and click **Print**.

If you want to run the report for one major code, you can enter the individual code instead of **all**. Attached is a list of Major Codes. You may not have students in every major for your department. Expired Majors are included on the list because there may be students still enrolled in these majors.

Click **Submit**.

If the all option is used, once the report has run, click on your majors in the window on the left side of the screen. **Be careful when you print so you do not print the entire document.** To print only the current page, right click on the report page, select **Print**, click the **Current Page** radio button, and click **Print**.
