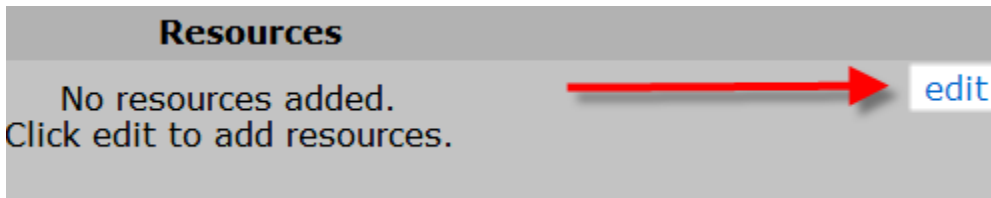

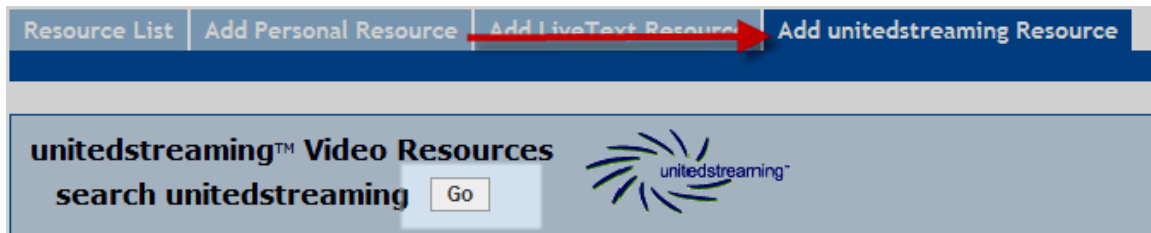
## Using UnitedStreaming Video®

UnitedStreaming Video is a wonderful asset to accompany your lesson plans, projects, etc. At a cost of \$20.00, you are provided access to a wide variety of videos that, at the click of a mouse, you can incorporate into your projects.

After you have either opened up an old project/lesson plan, you can retrieve a UnitedStreaming resource by going to the **Resources section** of your project and clicking **Edit**.

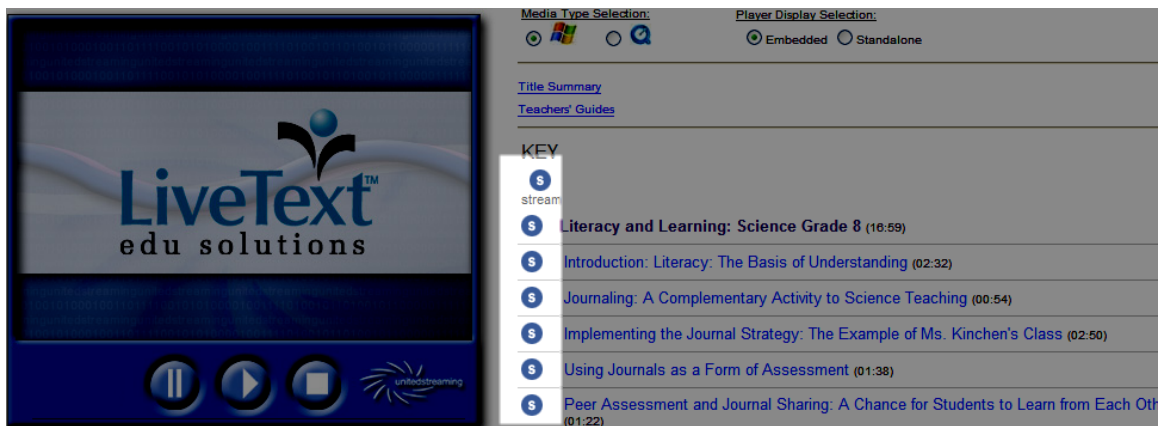


You will then see a number of tabs. Click on the one that says **“Add UnitedStreaming Resource”**.



Once you have hit that tab, click the **Go** button.

This will take you to the UnitedStreaming web site. Once at the site, type the desired topic by entering keywords in your search engine. You will find a variety of topics from which you can choose. Once you see a title in which you are interested, click the title. A new screen will appear where you can either stream sections of the video or the whole thing.



Once you see the section/video that you like, a text will appear on the bottom of the video screen that says “**Add to LiveText**”.



You will then be taken back to your project in LiveText's domain. When you have filled out all of the criteria for your video, complete the addition by clicking **finish**. You have now successfully added video to your project/lesson plan.
