

Eastern Illinois University Human Subjects Ethics Training Institutional Review Board—EDA 5900 Exercise

As discussed in class, educational research often requires the participation of human subjects. Federal law and university policy requires that certain processes, procedures and safeguards be utilized to ensure that persons who are involved in research projects are protected from unethical treatment. In order to conduct research, everyone must complete the ethics training outlined below and follow the requirements set forth therein. At the end of this on-line course, you will take a test. The results of that test will be reported electronically to the EIU IRB for their records. You will receive a certificate of completion.

1. Go to the EIU homepage
