CELEBRATION FOOD CONCESSIONS - Terms & Conditions and FAQs

- Foods of international or unusual character will receive the highest consideration by the Planning Committee.
- The food concessions fee is \$300, payable at the time the application is submitted. In addition, a five-percent (5%) of gross sales is payable to the festival director at the conclusion of the festival.
- Application deadline is Friday, April 5, 2019. Applications not post-marked by this date will not be considered.
- Notifications of approval or rejection will be sent out via mail or email the week of April 8th, 2019.
- Applicants must include insurance verification when submitting an application.
- Mail Application, Insurance Verification, and Entry Fee to: Celebration, 600 Lincoln Ave., Charleston, IL 61920.
- Applicants must comply with Coles County Health Department regulations and complete a Temporary Food Permit Application prior to the festival. Vendors are subject to an inspection during the festival.
- <u>Mail the Temporary Food Permit Application to</u>: Coles County Health Department located at 825 18th Street, Charleston, IL 61920.
- Celebration will cover the cost of the Coles County Health Department inspection fee for approved participating
 vendors providing the application is returned prior to the deadline. After the deadline the CCHD inspection fee is
 \$50.00 and will be the responsibility of the vendor to pay directly to the CCHD.
- Vendors are subject to an inspection during the festival.
- The Health Department requires all propane tanks must be secured to the booth. No free-standing propane tanks!
- Electric power is restricted to appliances for maintaining serving temperature as required by the Health Department. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact Dennis Malak to discuss electrical power needs. Requests must be made two weeks prior to the festival. Electrical requests made at the festival CANNOT be accommodated.
- SET-UP DAY, Thursday, April 25th at 5:00 p.m. and NOT before. Please DO NOT show up early, this contributes to congestion as EIU employees are leaving campus. NO EXCEPTIONS. If you arrive in town early you will need to wait at a location away from campus. Idle-parking is not permitted on South 9th Street and you will be ticketed. Food vendors are not placed on a first-come, first-arrival basis. Food vendors are assigned to a specific location determined by the festival organizers.

When is the Festival?

Friday, April 26th through Sunday, April 28th, 2019

When is the application deadline?

Friday, April 5th , 2019 – acceptance letters sent out the week of April 8th.

Where does the festival take place?

South 7th Street, South of Eastern Illinois University's Doudna Fine Arts Center, Charleston, Illinois.

What are the hours of the booth?

Friday: 11:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturday: 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday: 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

How much is the booth fee?

\$300 and five-percent (5%) of gross sales.

What does the booth fee include?

Booth location, limited electricity, water and trash service.

When can food concessions set-up?

Set-up will be Thursday beginning at 5 p.m. The organizing committee will contact each vendor with a specific time when their trailer will be set in place.

How many food vendors participate?

There is space for 10 primary food vendors.
