The recipient must, in thought and deed, be a living example of the ideals and values expressed by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Documentation such as essay or letter of support (please attach to application) should be provided for recipient as to how their life mirrors the ideals of Dr. King, e.g., service to one's fellow humans, without reference to gender, race or national origin and/or how their activities make the world around them a better environment.
