## **Scholarship Criteria**

The scholarship award recipient(s) shall be enrolled and accepted as a full-time student at Eastern Illinois University for the Fall 2017 semester. The recipient(s) must be a graduate of one of the Coles County High Schools. The Selection Committee shall require a one-page essay/narrative of the applicants that demonstrates the student's potential to succeed and attach essay to application. Financial need is a consideration. The recipient(s) may be eligible to apply for, and receive, the award again provided she/he continues to meet the criteria stated above.

The award(s) shall be payable in the Fall 2017 Semester to Eastern Illinois University to be first applied against costs (tuition, fees, housing, etc.) associated with the recipient(s) attending Eastern Illinois University. Any remaining amount will be disbursed to the recipient(s).
