	Currently have 14,000 students enrolled; there's been a major staff upheaval, creating challenges; public safety is in charge of Clery/Title IX issues; local coalition is still going strong at 22 years. ESD/IHEC IHEC and HERC have successfully moved to Booth House, Open House on September 29; students doing AlcoholEdu and Haven; Sexual Assault Task Force has been formed.
