Attaching Files to Powerpoint (Microsoft 07)

- 1. Open the files from the email and save them somewhere you can retrieve them from (desktop, jump drive, etc.)
- 2. Open the ECALC powerpoint and save this somewhere as well.
- 3. Re-open the powerpoint from the saved location
- 4. In powerpoint go to slide 7
 - a. The go to the "Insert" tab and click "Sound" where it says media clips on the far right.
 - b. Select "Sound from file" and then find the Tequila Ad audio clip
 - c. It will show up as a little speaker icon on the slide and then it will ask you "How do you want the sound to start in the slide show?" Select when clicked.
 - i. When giving the presentation you then need to clip on the little speaker icon to play the clip.
- 5. For the Marlatt clip, go to slide 15
 - a. Repeat the steps for the audio clip, but instead select "Movie" and "Movie from file."
 - b. The video clips how up as black boxes. Expand these to take up the whole slide
- 6. Repeat again for slide 21 with the Ad 5 clip and for slide 22 with Ad 6 clip.
- 7. If you want to transport the presentation to another computer and keep the clips embedded, you have to copy the presentation along with all the clips onto a jump drive or burn it to a disk.

If you are using Microsoft 2010 the options are Audio and Video instead of Sound and Movie but the process is the same
