To the City Council,
Chicago, Ill.,

We the undersigned, Officers and Members of the Chicago Teamster's Union No. 1 representing Three thousand, seven hundred and fifty members, affiliated with the American Federation of Labor, Illinois State Federation of Labor, International Federation and Chicago Trade and Labor Assembly, do hereby respectfully pray and memorialize your Honorable body to have an Ordinance passed in the City Council as follows.

1st, Any Teamster employed by the City Government must belong to the Chicago Teamster's Union No. 1, and be a member in good standing in the above Union.

2nd, The above section ^{does not include} ~~debars~~ Firemen who drive Hose Carts, Fire Engines and Hook & Ladders.

3rd, Any contracts given out by the City Government to Street Cleaners, Scavengers, etc. that employ teamsters must specify in the specification to said contractor who obtains the contract from the City Government must employ Union Teamsters.

4th, Any Teamster employed by the City Government must be a Citizen of the United States.

~~5th,~~ Any Teamster employed by the City Government must be Twenty-one years old or over.

This Chicago Teamster's Union No. 1, is calculated to promote education, awaken high ideas, stimulate healthy imagination, help the injured and sick and receive more wages for our labor and less hours.

Hoping your Honorable Body will take immediate action, upon the above and in the near future the Chicago Teamster's Union No. 1; will not forget this small favor granted by your Honorable Body.
