

Anti-Draft Film to the Censor Again

Before the United States entered the war Nazimova made her debut in the movies with "War Brides," a film that was criticized even at that time because of its anti-draft theme.

Now, with the United States in the war, the film is back again before the city censorship bureau in revised form on an application for a new permit, and the chances of its being approved are said to be about fifty-fifty.

"The picture has been made anti-German," said Charles E. Frazier, acting second deputy superintendent of police. But there is still the question whether the federal authorities would approve it, because the anti-draft theme is still there."
