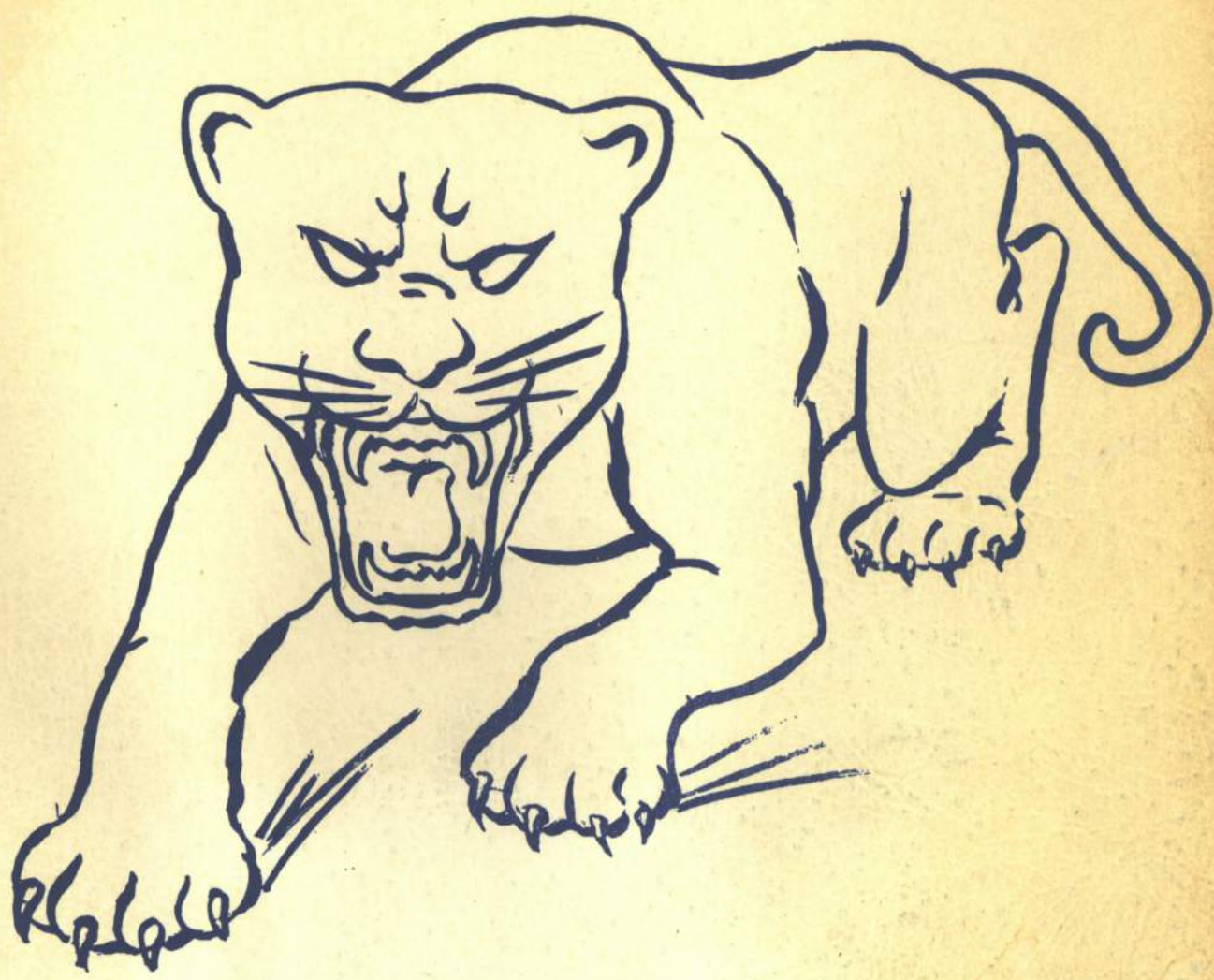

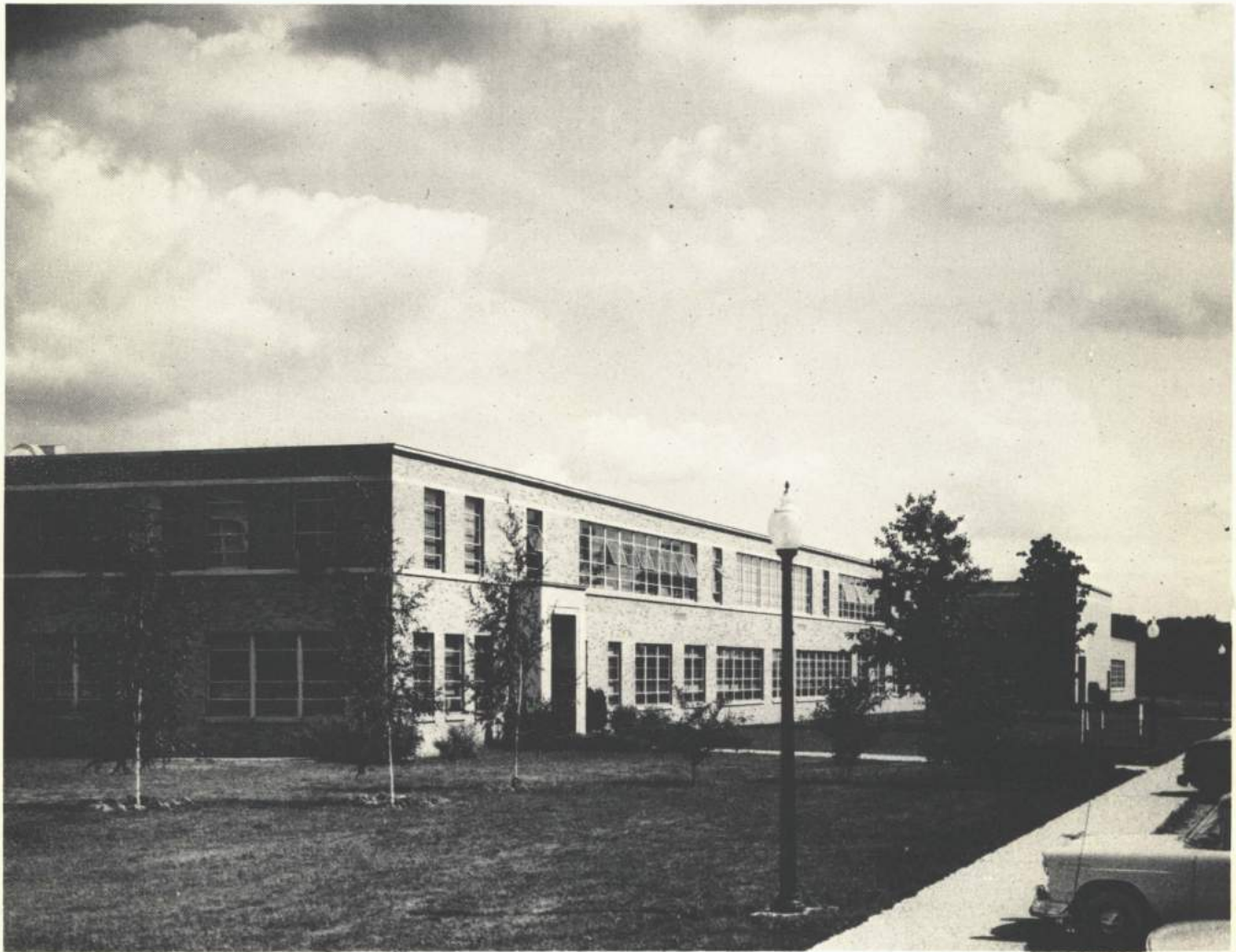

Principal's Message

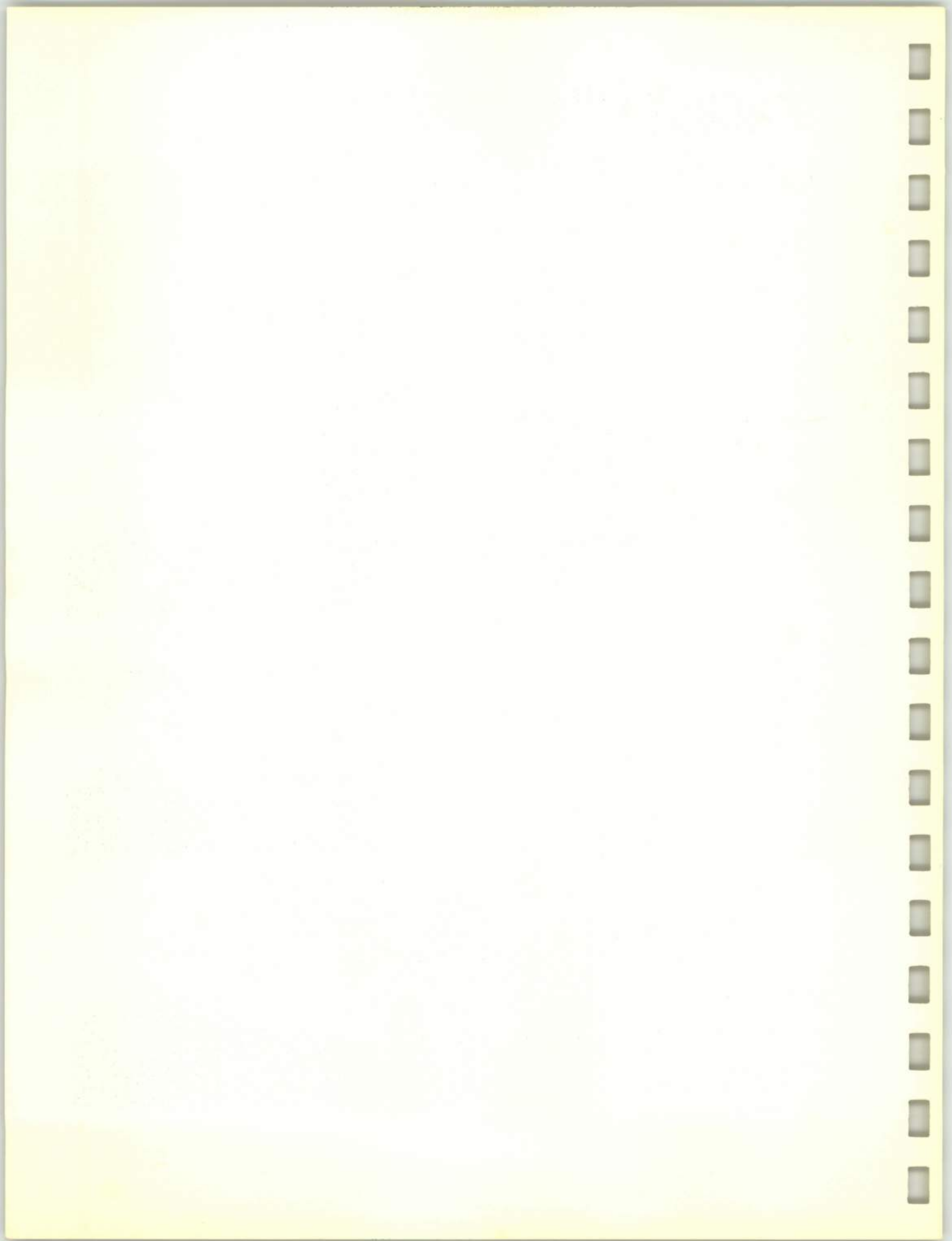


FRANCIS E. SUMMERS
