A Proclamation

Whereas the President of the United States by his proclamation dated July 15th 1863, has set apart Thursday August the 11th 1863, to be observed as a day of National thanksgiving, praise and prayer:

Now therefore, I, Francis C. Sherman, Mayor of the City of Chicago, do hereby recommend to the Citizens of Chicago, the due observance of that day, by abstaining from all secular employments and assembling in their usual places of public worship to render thanksgiving praise and prayer to Almighty God, in accordance with the proclamation of the President of the United States.
