In the traditional 2+2 program, students may choose to attend EIU for two years before transferring to any of a number of accredited programs offering a baccalaureate degree in nursing (BSN) and the knowledge and preparation to pass the certification exam required to become a registered nurse (RN).

Since your BSN will be awarded by another institution, you must meet the requirements of that institution. Each program has its own requirements; Therefore, it is pertinent to identify their posted requirements. The websites listed in the "Resources" section will provide information on admission requirements, costs, financial aid, etc at the various 2+2 programs in the state of Illinois.

Note that a 2.75 GPA is the minimum accepted at many programs. However, due to the competition, it typically takes a higher GPA to gain admission.

Current CPR Certification. Verification of current certification in CPR is a prerequisite for enrollment in most nursing programs. Accepted courses are: The American Heart Association – Basic Life Support (CPR and AED Program)  OR The American Red Cross – Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers.
All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or above. Completion of a minimum of 60 credit hours of general education and prerequisite courses.
Possible admissions test: Kaplan, TEAS, etc.
