 School 2.0 is the vision for the next generation of education that takes advantage of emerging Web 2.0 technologies.


What is Web 2.0?

- · Voice/Video over IP (Skype)
- · RSS and Aggregators (content comes to you)

What's the big deal?

- · Ease of use
- Time-Shifted & Place-Shifted (books also do this)
- Authorship (Sharing in the creation of content, from spectator to creator)
