iEntrepreneur Challenge YouTube Video Contest Gets Students Talking with Entrepreneurs

Charleston, IL - All area junior and senior high school and college students have the opportunity to win a 16GB iPad 2 by creating a two minute YouTube video that asks entrepreneurs what they have learned from their failures. The Business Solutions Center at Eastern Illinois University (BSC), in partnership with Eastern Illinois Development Corporation (ECIDC), is holding their 2nd Annual iEntrepreneur Challenge, a video contest that will help celebrate Global Entrepreneurship Week. "We want to give students the opportunity to speak with successful entrepreneurs and learn from their experience," said Jeanne Dau, Director of the Business Solutions Center. "Many people feel that they learn more from their failures than their successes, so this should make for interested viewing."
