- In AY21, a total of 571 courses were represented in the EWP submissions; AY21 shows an increase of 35 courses from which students chose to submit.
- In AY21 1,406 submissions of the total submissions came from WI/WC courses ( $45.66 \%$ ) of the submissions for the AY); this percentage shows a decrease of $2.34 \%$ from the previous AY in WI/WC submissions. In AY21, 155 courses (27\%) of the total courses for the AY came from WI/WC courses, which shows a decrease of $1 \%$ from the previous AY courses.
- Only one submission was received from 194 courses. The most submissions came from ENG 1002G with 131 submissions followed by ENG 1001 G with 85 submissions. A total of 352 submissions were received from the 21 senior seminar courses.
