- In AY19, a total of 537 courses were represented in the EWP submissions; AY19 shows a decrease of 223 courses from which students chose to submit.
- In AY19, 1,651 submissions of the total submissions came from WI/WC courses ( $48 \%$ of the submissions for the FY); this percentage shows a decrease of $6 \%$ from the previous AY18 in WI/WC submissions. In AY19, 167 courses ( $31 \%$ of the total courses for the year came from WI/WC courses, which shows an increase of $1 \%$ from the previous AY18 courses.
- Only one submission was received from 152 courses. The most submissions came from ENG 1001G with 133 submissions followed by ENG 1002G with 104 submissions. A total of 375 submissions were received from the 22 senior seminar courses.
