- In AY20, a total of 536 courses were represented in the EWP submissions; AY20 shows a decrease of 1 course from which students chose to submit.
- In AY20, 1,441 submissions of the total submissions came from WI/WC courses (48% of the submissions for the FY); this percentage is the same as the previous academic year. In AY20, 149 courses (28% of the total courses for the year came from WI/WC courses, which shows a decrease of 3% from the previous AY19 courses.
- Only one submission was received from 175 courses (+23 courses from AY19) and 86 courses had 2 submissions. The most submissions came from ENG 1002G with 121 submissions followed by ENG 1001G with 110 submissions. A total of 338 submissions were received from the 19 senior seminar courses.
