- In SP18, a total of 350 courses were represented in the EWP submissions; SP18 shows a decrease of 11 courses from which students chose to submit.
- In SP18, 740 submissions of the 1686 total submissions came from WI/WC courses (44% of the submissions for the semester); this percentage shows a decrease of 4% from the previous spring in WI/WC submissions. In SP17, 882 of the total 1,822 submissions came from WI/WC courses (48% of total), which shows a 1% increase from the previous year in SP16.
- Only one submission was received from 99 courses. The most submissions came from ENG 1002 with 74 submissions followed by ENG 1001 and EIU 4115G each with 35 submissions and BUS 3200 with 30 submissions. A total of 151 submissions were received from the senior seminar courses.
