- \_\_\_\_\_ Obtain and document passing scores on the Illinois Test of Basic Skills (Fee)
- Registration materials are available in the Dean's Office, College of Education & Professional Studies, 1420 Buzzard Hall
  - Test dates are limited and registration deadlines are approximately 6 weeks prior to test dates
- \_\_\_\_\_ Established minimum cumulative GPA of 2.65/4.0 scale.
- Transfer students may use transfer GPA if have attended meeting and passed basic skills test within first 30 days at EIU
  - Post-bac students must have a cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.65 (from the institution where they received their baccalaureate degree) or have completed a Master's degree with a GPA of 3.0

### **Major Department & University Approval To Student Teach**

\_\_\_\_\_ Attend Application to Student Teach Meeting

- Meetings are held each Fall
- Students must attend the meeting the Fall semester preceding the academic year they plan to student teach.

\_\_\_\_\_ Receive Department Approval to Student Teach

- Maintain cumulative GPA of 2.65/4.0 (some programs may be higher)
- Major GPA of 2.65/4.0 (some programs may be higher)
- Complete all professional education courses with a grade of “C” or better
- Evidence of recent participation in professional organizations, meetings, and appropriate activities with youth ages 3-18
- Submit portfolio to major department (Consult department for specifics)
- Meet other department specific criteria

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete the second required Criminal Background Investigation (Fee)

\_\_\_\_\_ Pass the appropriate Illinois Certification subject-matter knowledge test(s) for the program being completed (Fee)

### **Other Requirements**

\_\_\_\_\_ Pass the Assessment of Professional Teaching Test (Fee)

\_\_\_\_\_ Complete certification application that will be provided by student teaching coordinator
