EIU Student Teachers: Helping create effective educational environments

Program Highlights:

- ◆ *83% of EIU teacher certification graduates are still teaching after 5 years.*
- ◆ *All certification programs require extensive school-based work throughout the program.*

All EIU Student Teachers:

- ◆ Have passed the appropriate Content Area Test(s) prior to student teaching;
- ◆ Undergo two (2) Criminal Background Checks, including an FBI Fingerprint Scan in the semester prior to student teaching;
- ◆ Have between 100 and 400+ hours in public schools, working with learners, prior to student teaching;
- ◆ Must complete a full semester of student teaching (15-16 weeks);
- ◆ Are supervised and evaluated by EIU faculty members with extensive public school experience, dedicated to teacher mentoring;
- ◆ Have a TB screening within 90 days of the start of the student teaching; *and*
- ◆ Are trained in appropriate use of instructional technology.

Potential Cooperating Teachers – do you:

- Possess a sincere desire to work with a student teacher and share your room?
- Possess personal qualities essential to good supervision: practical insight into interpersonal relationships, understanding of social class structure, and a wide cultural background?
- Hold licensure and are qualified for the subjects, age range, and setting in which you teach? (May include additional endorsements.)
- Have a minimum of three years of successful teaching experience?
- Have a Master's degree or the equivalent in additional study?
- Possess and exhibit a genuine professional interest to improve teaching through further college or university study and participation in activities having a direct relationship to the field, such as travel or related work experience?
- Strive to exhibit professional enthusiasm, and endeavor to be an exemplary model for the teaching profession?
