To submit a nomination:

- 1.) Answer the 5 short answer questions
- 2.) Write an optional essay
- 3.) Deliver to the College of Sciences Office (Old Main 2118)
- 4.) Provide cover page with contact information

It is recommended applications are typed; however, written applications are accepted. If you choose to type this nomination, please limit your response to 4 pages double-spaced.

1.) If you could sum-up your professor in one word, what word would you choose? Explain.

2.) What have you learned from this professor? How did they facilitate your learning?

3.) What has this professor done to impact students through other services outside of the classroom (i.e. Registered Student Organization involvement, research, field experience, advising, etc.)?

4.) How has this professor impacted your future career goals? How has this professor assisted you in achieving these goals?

5.) What contributions has this professor made to his/her field of study?

6.) Optional essay in which additional information about the nominated professor may be included.
