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1 Project Introduction

EISE is an acronym for the Enterprise Information System Enhancement project. EISE is a major technology venture to ensure the continued delivery of mission critical and core services to students, employees, parents, alumni, supporters and business partners. This four year project will replace all of the University's major information systems with cost-effective, integrated and sustainable technology while incorporating exceptional business practices. The primary technology solution product is Banner from SunGard SCT Inc.

2 Requirements

Requirements can be classified by many means. Within this document requirements will be classified by category and approach. A category addresses the function that the requirement fulfills and the type defines the requirement that is satisfied in terms of the SCT deliverable or work product required in fulfilling the requirement. A list and examples are as follows:

Category Classification:

Technology	Feasibility, Maturity, Custom
Function	Features, Benefits
Regulatory	Government Regulations, Warranty, Legal Issues
Business/Financial	Budget, ROI, Pricing, Inflation, Strategic, Contract Type

Market	Competition, Industry Regulations, Language
Schedule	Feasibility, Milestones, Completion Date
Education	Training, Knowledge Transfer
Quality	Meets Standards Established by User

Approach Classification:

Type	Example
Baseline Functionality	The baseline SCT product/service can support the requirement.
Business Process or Procedure	The current business process is not supported by the baseline SCT product/service but if it is "re-engineered," the SCT product/service can support the requirement.
Custom Enhancement	Neither the baseline SCT product/services nor a process/procedure change can support the requirement, consequently a modification or enhancement must be developed to support the requirement.
