Parking Information:

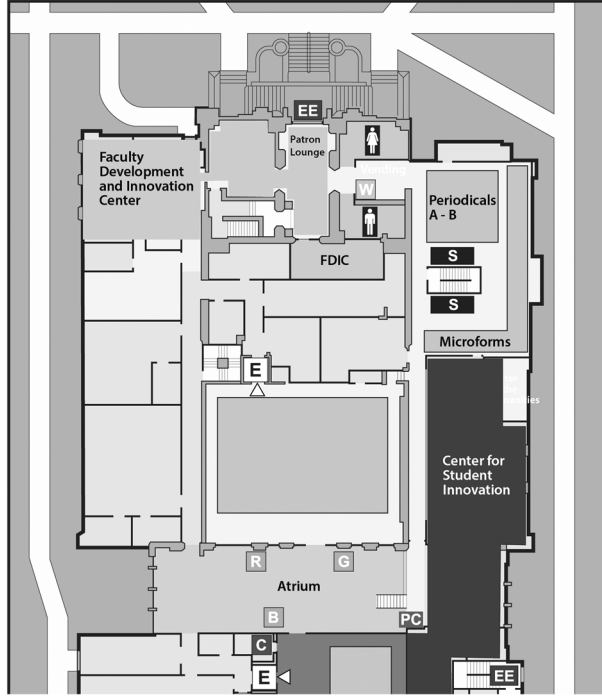

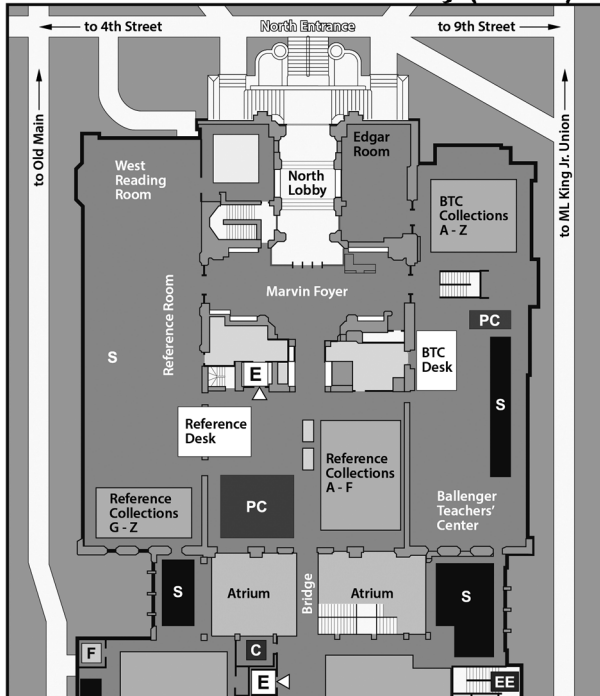

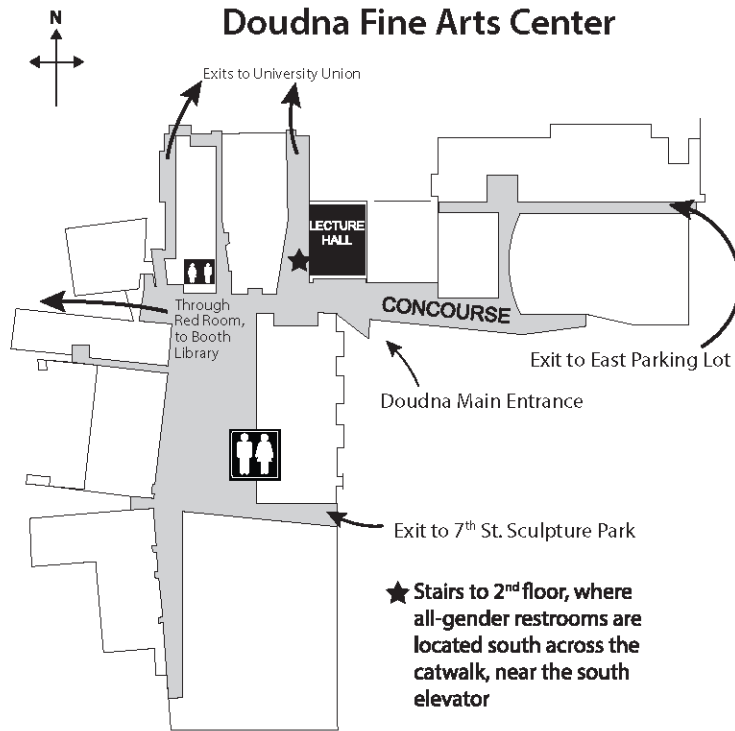

1000 Level of Booth Library (North)

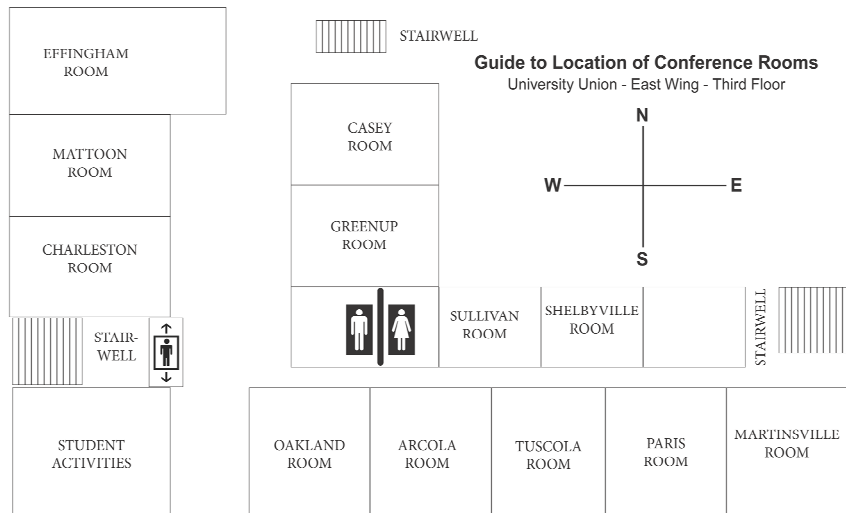


3000 Level of Booth Library (North)
