Barbara J. Millis, Director of the Excellence in Teaching Program at the University of Nevada at Reno, received her Ph.D. in English literature from Florida State University. The former Director of Faculty Development at the US Air Force Academy (USAFA), she frequently offers workshops at professional conferences (AAHE, Lilly Teaching Conferences, etc.) and for over 300 colleges and universities. She publishes articles on a variety of faculty development topics such as cooperative learning, peer classroom observations (she was a FIPSE Project Director on that topic), the teaching portfolio, microteaching, syllabus construction, classroom assessment/research, critical thinking, writing for publication, focus groups, writing across the curriculum, academic games, and course redesign. While at USAFA, Barbara won both a teaching award and a research award, and after the Association of American Colleges and Universities selected the Academy as a Leadership Institution in Undergraduate Education in 2001, she began serving as the liaison to the AAC&U's Greater Expectations Consortium on Quality Education. In 2002, Barbara loved being a Visiting Scholar at Victoria University, Wellington, New Zealand.
