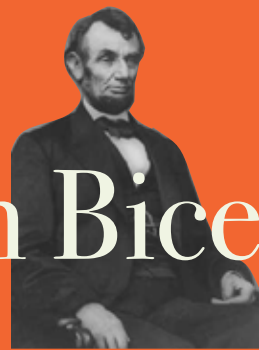

Professor Weber is the author of *Copperheads: The Rise and Fall of Lincoln's Opponents in the North* (Oxford, 2006). She started her professional life as a journalist and later worked as a political aide in the California State Legislature. A lifelong interest in the Civil War eventually spurred her to pursue academics as a career at Princeton University, where she received a Ph.D. in 2000. She is currently researching a book about conscription in the North and South during the Civil War.
