

Qualities of Honors Courses at Eastern Illinois University

An ideal Honors Course at Eastern Illinois University should ...

- **Encourage critical and analytical thinking, and provide ample opportunity for structured reflection;**
- **Incorporate problem-solving skills;**
- **Engage students in the learning process;**
- **Sharpen communication skills;**
- **Be integrative, and connect skills and knowledge from multiple courses and experiences;**
- **Accentuate one-on-one interaction;**
- **Exhibit inquiry-based learning;**
- **Encourage collaboration in assignments and projects;**
- **Encourage intellectual curiosity and intellectual risk taking;**
- **Evidence openness to new ideas;**
- **Demonstrate pedagogical innovation and experimentation;**

As appropriate to the scope and focus of the course, Honors courses should also ...

- **Be interdisciplinary;**
- **Emphasize diversity and global learning, and encourage intercultural knowledge and competence;**
- **Be writing intensive;**
- **Emphasize service-learning and community based-learning in order to allow for real-world application of knowledge.**
