

## EIU Residential Network (ResNet) User Agreement

1. I understand that I need an Ethernet adapter installed in my computer to be able to connect to the EIU Residential Network. I acknowledge that installing an Ethernet card is my responsibility, and that:
2. I understand that I need a wireless adapter installed in my computer to be able to connect wirelessly, when applicable, to the EIU Residential Network. I acknowledge that installing an Ethernet card is my responsibility, and that:
  - a. Not all wireless cards work on the EIU Residential Network, and I will be responsible for purchasing a card that meets the EIU specifications (<http://its.eiu.edu/student-computer-hardwaresoftware-recommendations.php>) if the card I have does not work.
3. I understand that I will need to purchase a CAT 6 cable to connect the Ethernet card in my computer to the network port in my room. I acknowledge that the network interface cable must be treated with care so that it performs properly, and that
  - a. Cables are available for sale at the residence hall front desks. The cost is \$15.
4. I understand that I am responsible for any damage to my computer or computer software that may result from trying to connect to the network. I acknowledge that the University does not have technicians available to make repairs to student-owned hardware, and I agree to contract with a computer hardware vendor or commercial facility to complete any necessary diagnosis or repairs to my equipment so that it will be compatible with the network, and that:
  - a. If my attempt to connect to the network causes problems, the data port(s) in my room may be deactivated, and the port(s) will not be reactivated until the problem is corrected to the satisfaction of the University.
  - b. I HAVE made backup copies of operating system and application software.
5. I understand that my usage of the EIU Residential Network must be in compliance with the University's computer Acceptable Use Policy, and that:
  - a. One element of that policy is a prohibition on any use which results in commercial gain or private profit (other than allowable under University intellectual property policies).
