

I-20 Mailing Instructions for Applicants Outside of the United States

For international applicants who currently reside outside the U.S., the I-20 is sent by U.S. airmail to your mailing address, or the permanent address if no mailing address is available. Specialized mail service (Federal Express, UPS, etc.) cannot be provided by the Office of International Students and Scholars. We do permit you to designate a representative (relative or friend) currently residing in the U.S. to receive your I-20 so that special mail service can be arranged by this person. Please indicate below where your I-20 should be mailed.

____ I am authorizing the following person, who is currently in the U.S., to be my designated representative. Please send my I-20 to this person so that special mail service can be arranged.
