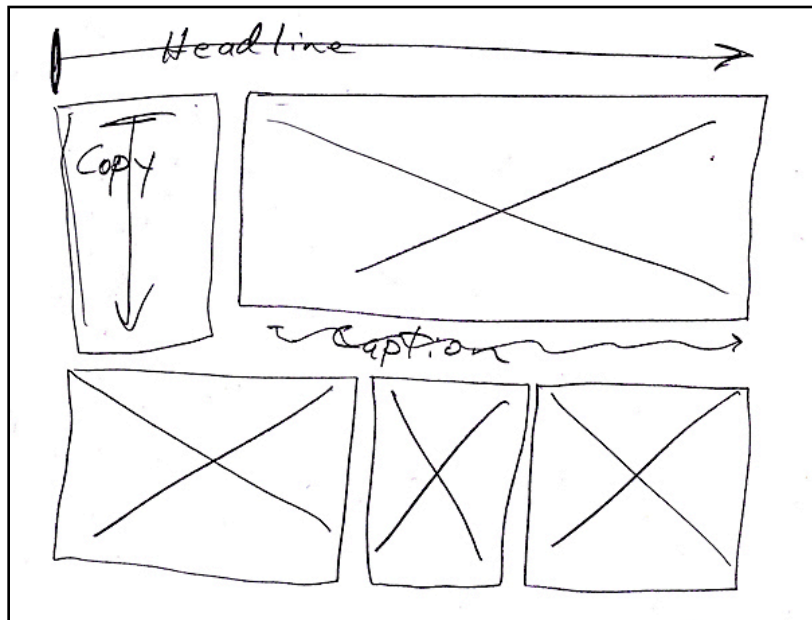


JOU 2950 Final Project: *the photo story*

The final project for JOU 2950 is a photo story/essay that is due at the last regular class meeting.

Tips on completing the project:

- Edit your photos. Select only the ones that are necessary to relay the theme. Remember, there should be at least one example of each view (overall, mid-range, detail/close-up). Avoid redundant images.
- Sketch a page dummy. (example at right).
- Create a new document with Pages or InDesign.
- Place, arrange and align the headline, images, copy blocks/captions and any other elements on the new document.
- Save the document, then print the finished photo page as a pdf file.



Turning in the project for grading:

- Create a new folder on your computer and name it **final-your initials**.
- Place the Pages or InDesign document in this folder.
- Place the pdf version of the finished document in this folder.
- Place copies of only the photos that appear on the document in this folder. These photos may be named anyway you wish, but they should be about the same size as those that appear on the document. For this project photos should be no larger than 150 pixel/inch. There is no need to write captions in the photo file info since captions will appear on the document.
- Drop the folder into your instructor's Drop folder.

Grading criteria:

250 points total with half of the points awarded for the design and story-telling power of the essay and half for the quality of the photos.
