Nomination Form

To submit a nomination:

1. Fill out the information form below.
2. Write a short essay explaining why you think this professor/instructor deserves the Outstanding Teacher Award and attach it to this form. Consider the following information:
 - How has your professor facilitated your learning?
 - What has your professor done to impact students through other services outside of the classroom (i.e. field experience, advising, cooperative research, registered student organization involvement, etc.)?
 - What has your professor done to contribute to his/her field of study?
 - How has your professor impacted your future career goals and assisted you in achieving these goals?
 - Any other relevant information.
3. Deliver all of the completed forms to the main KSS office (2506 Lantz Arena).

Nominations are due by the last Thursday of March during the spring semester of each academic school year.

“KSS Honors Club Outstanding Teacher Award”
Guidelines

1. A committee consisting of at least one KSS Honors Club representative from each concentration (Exercise Science, Sport Management, Athletic Training, and Teacher Certification) will decide who is deserving of this award. If a representative from each concentration area is not available, the committee reserves the right to make the final decision.
2. The elected officers of the KSS Honors Club will be granted a position on the award committee, if they wish to accept that position.
3. Nominations are accepted from any KSS major and/or faculty, but the KSS Honors Club Outstanding Teacher Award committee, based on the nominations received, will decide the recipient of the award.
4. The President of the KSS Honors Club will lead the committee and will only have a vote in the case of a tie. The President will be the deciding factor if the other members of the committee do not come to a consensus.
5. All nominations from students will be anonymous.
6. All nominations must be approved by the faculty member being nominated.
7. Faculty will be asked to submit a copy of his/her curriculum vitae to the student that is nominating them. Students will turn in the vitae with the nomination form and essay.
8. The nomination form, vitae, and essay must be turned in by the last Thursday of March.
9. The committee will evaluate each nomination according to the criteria stated on the nomination form, the essay written on the nominee, and the faculty vitae.
10. The committee will have an open discussion to give their opinions on the nomination forms and a vote will be conducted with equal representation from all concentrations.
11. A faculty member can only receive this award once every three years.
