 - a. The Scholarship Application Form and Check Sheet. Your signature on this form **must certify** that you qualify for **all** criteria for the scholarship(s) for which you are applying. Place a check mark in the box next to each scholarship you are applying for (see second page).
 - b. A letter of application. This letter will include why you are applying for the scholarship and why you feel qualified to receive it. Please keep to a maximum of 1 typed page.
 - c. Current resume.
 - d. Faculty Recommendation Form(s). There is a separate form for each scholarship. The Faculty Recommendation Form must be filled out by a faculty member with whom you have taken a professional course (within the Department of Kinesiology & Sports Studies). Academic advisors, unless you have taken a class with him/her, are not to be used. The faculty member(s) will fill out and turn this form in to the Kinesiology & Sports Studies Office.
2. Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. Students who are awarded scholarships will be notified by phone by Friday, April 13, 2012.
4. Recipients will be invited and honored at the Kinesiology & Sports Studies Awards Day on Friday, April 20, 2012.

Kinesiology & Sports Studies Scholarships

Check the box next to each scholarship you are applying for.

- Athletic Training Scholarship: Undergraduate student majoring in the Athletic Training Program; demonstrate a sincere interest and dedication to the Athletic Training Program as a career; selection of the recipient shall take into consideration: peer evaluation, staff evaluation, academic qualifications (overall GPA, last semester GPA and GPA for Athletic Training courses; clinical experiences evaluation; financial need is NOT a consideration.
- Barbara Snow Award: Senior status; female Kinesiology & Sports Studies major who has graduated, or who is scheduled to graduate within the academic year in which the award is made; demonstrates excellence in leadership (demonstrates inspiration and enrichment), performance (reflects outstanding quality), and scholarship (exemplifies true intellectual endeavor); cumulative GPA of 3.0; may be given to more than one student; nomination should be accompanied by a statement of qualifications as related to leadership, performance and scholarship.
- Dolly and H. Gene McFarland Scholarship: Full-time student; Kinesiology & Sports Studies major; accepted to EIU; working towards teaching certification; resident of Illinois; minimum GPA of 2.5; university and community service of the recipient may be considered; financial need IS a consideration.
- Dorothy M. Hart Memorial Scholarship: Overall GPA of at least 3.0/4.0; active in departmental activities (KSS Club, KSS Honor's Club, Recreational Sports) in a leadership capacity; good character; strong moral value; bring credit to EIU and the Physical Education profession; if a transfer student, the recipient must have attended at least one semester at EIU to establish eligibility; recipient should NOT be receiving other significant financial aid (Grant-In-Aid, athletic scholarship, etc.).
- Dr. & Mrs. Richard H. Larson Athletic Training Scholarship: Junior or senior status; full-time student majoring in Athletic Training; accepted to EIU; must have completed three semesters in the Athletic Training Program or its successor; financial need is not a requirement.
- Errett & Mazie Warner Presidential Award: Junior or senior status; outstanding scholastic achievement (minimum of a "B" average); outstanding character whose actions and conduct reflect with credit upon EIU; financial need IS a consideration.
- Florence McAfee Scholarship: Sophomore or junior status; female majoring in Women's Physical Education; outstanding academic ability; leadership skills; high personal and ethical qualities; departmental participation; prove future contribution to Women's Physical Education; financial need is not a consideration.
- Larry Ankenbrand Scholarship: Junior, senior, or graduate student status; full-time student; Kinesiology & Sports Studies major; accepted to EIU; minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Mike & Phoebe Church Scholarship: Junior status (must have completed a minimum of 90 hours when receiving this award); must have been enrolled at EIU for a minimum of 4 semesters when receiving this award; must be enrolled in the Kinesiology & Sports Studies Teacher Certification option and have plans to teach Physical Education in the public schools upon graduation; active in one or more departmental service activities (KSS Club, KSS Honors Club, Recreational Sports, volunteer work, etc.); overall GPA of at least 3.25/4.0; must be considered to have high moral character and must be considered to be an "excellent role model" for children of all ages as both 'a teacher and a coach' in the public schools.
- Robert W. and Laura M. Hussey Scholarship: Must be a full-time student majoring in Kinesiology and Sports Studies with the K-12 Teacher Certification option, and accepted to Eastern Illinois University. Must have completed all of the required departmental methods courses within the Department of Kinesiology and Sports Studies and be eligible to student teach during one of the following two semesters. Must maintain a GPA of at least 3.0. Financial need is a consideration. The recipient(s) are not eligible to receive the award more than once.
- Shannon McNamara Outstanding Physical Education Major Award: Outstanding character; high scholarship; active in Kinesiology & Sports Studies department through departmental service and a member of the KSS Club; potential to be an outstanding role model in physical education; must be a Kinesiology & Sports Studies major.
- William H. Groves Memorial Award: Junior status (if no junior applies for the award, preference shall go to a sophomore; if no sophomore applies for the award, preference shall then go to a graduate student in Kinesiology & Sports Studies); member of the intercollegiate swimming team at EIU; must fully intend to compete as a member with the swim team during his/her senior year at EIU; must show other qualities (personal swimming improvement, leadership qualities, and high academic standing); preference shall be given to students majoring or minoring in Kinesiology & Sports Studies.
