**VOTING ON PROPOSAL TO CHANGE FCS MERCHANDISING CONCENTRATION  
UNDER FCS: ACHM OPTION**

Vote taken. Approved.

**VOTING ON REVISED COURSE PROPOSAL – MGT 3330, LEGAL ASPECT OF ENTREPRENEURSHIP**

Vote taken. Approved. (Motion was made and approved later to hold this proposal from CAA until after issues with MGT 3320 are resolved since MGT 3320 is a prerequisite to MGT 3330).

**VOTING ON REVISED COURSE PROPOSAL – MGT 3320, ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND SMALL BUSINESS**

Motion made to approve. Chadd expressed concerns about content overlap with CTE 1420 and stated that approximately ninety percent of what is being proposed by this revised course is also taught in CTE 1420. Roszkowski explained that much of what is currently being taught in CTE 1420 was not in the original proposal for that course but agreed that there was overlap. Roszkowski stated that MGT 3320 was targeting different students. Motion to approve was withdrawn. Motion made and approved to table the proposal until issues with the School of Technology are resolved.

**FCS 5901, STATISTICAL ANALYSIS IN FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCES**

Taylor presented the proposal explaining that students in the FCS graduate students have statistical deficiencies. This course would benefit all FCS graduate students. The committee stated that this proposed course overlapped with BUS 2810 and other graduate programs with statistic courses. It was suggested that the proposal be amended, perhaps through the outline and objectives, to target FCS graduate students. The proposal was placed on the agenda for voting at the first meeting in Fall 2009.
