Preparing for Lakeview College of Nursing

Eastern Illinois University has a partnership with Lakeview College of Nursing. After completing 2 years at Eastern Illinois University, the student would then transfer to Lakeview College of Nursing to complete the coursework necessary to satisfy a Baccalaureate in Nursing (BSN). When enrolled at Lakeview, the student will pay Lakeview tuition, however they may live on the EIU campus and use all of the campus services. Lakeview College of Nursing requires a minimum 2.50/4.00 prerequisite gpa to be considered for admission. Note that a 2.50 gpa is the **minimum** accepted. **However**, due to the competition, it typically takes a higher gpa to gain admission.

Lakeview will not accept any cards/certificates from internet based CPR courses).

- All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or above. Completion of a minimum of 60 credit hours of general education and prerequisite courses and 64 credit hours in nursing, totaling 124 semester hours in accordance with the curriculum plan, is required in order to earn Lakeview's BSN Degree.
