Diagnostic and Remedial Reading Program

The Diagnostic and Remedial Reading Program is organized to provide individualized programs for children in Grades 1 through 7 who may not be achieving up to their full potential in reading. Clinicians, will assess reading skills, implement needed instruction, and provide parents with a detailed case study.

Pupils will be selected for enrollment based on the judgment of reading specialists, classroom teachers, and principals as to the potential benefits to be gained from participation. This program will normally be offered during both the fall and spring semesters at Eastern Illinois University. Seating is limited, and priority will be given to pupils who are able to be present for the entire program.
