Pink Yink Ink Drink

Make sure your Yink is in the pink with this (not really ink) drink using fresh fruit, milk, and honey.

Ingredients

- ½ pint fresh or ½ cup frozen blackberries, thawed
- 1 cup milk
- 6 fresh strawberries, green tops removed, or ½ cup frozen, thawed
- 1 teaspoon honey

Directions

1. Put the blackberries in a blender and puree them.
2. Pour into a large glass.
3. Put the milk, strawberries, and honey in the blender and blend.
4. Strain the mixture (optional)
5. Pour the strawberry mixture carefully on top of blackberries.
