Sixteen (16) hours in student teaching are required: one eight (8) s.h. experience in an Elementary classroom, 1-5, and one, eight (8) s.h. experience in an LBS I classroom with individuals with varied exceptional learning needs, 6-12. You must have passed the Elementary content test, LBS I, and General Curriculum test <u>prior</u> to student teaching.

Credit in student teaching reflects successful completion of student teaching; the edTPA must be passed prior to licensure.
