POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

- Position:** Construction Technology – Assistant Professor Tenure-track.
- Responsibilities:** Teach hands-on courses in the areas of Construction Equipment & Materials, Surveying, Architectural Drafting, Cost Estimating, and Project Management. Additional teaching in the areas of instructional technology and graduate program will be required, as well as research and scholarly activities, service to the university, profession, and community in a NAIT accredited Industrial Technology program.
- Qualifications:** Earned doctorate in an appropriate discipline from a regionally accredited university required for tenure track position. Candidates must have excellent oral and written communication skills and at least one degree (preferably undergraduate) in Construction/Civil Engineering/Technology, Industrial Technology or Technology Education. Master's degree and coursework toward doctorate required for an annually contracted faculty position. This position may be converted to a tenure track position after the doctoral degree is conferred upon the candidate. Preference will be given to applicants with a combination of education and U.S. construction experience.
