Dear Colleagues,

I would like to extend an invitation to you to join Sigma Xi -- an honorary scientific research society whose mission is "to enhance the health of the research enterprise, foster integrity in science and engineering, and promote the public's understanding of science for the purpose of improving the human condition". This is a prestigious society with over 70,000 active members of which over 180 are Nobel Prize winners.

You can become a Sigma Xi member in one of three ways:

- 1. **"Full Membership** is conferred upon any individual who has shown noteworthy achievement as an original investigator in a field of pure or applied science or engineering. This noteworthy achievement is evidenced by publication as a **first author on two articles** published in a refereed journal, *patents*, *written reports or a thesis or dissertation*.
- 2. Associate Membership is available to any individual who has, through initial research achievement in a field of pure or applied science, shown an aptitude for research. An individual who has conducted independent investigation and written a report concerning their research is eligible for election to Associate Membership. Nominators are attesting to the nominee's potential to be promoted to Full Membership in the future. Associate Membership is offered to encourage young investigators with promise to continue careers in research.
- 3. If you do not know any Sigma Xi members who can nominate you, you can still become a member of the Society. You may contact the local chapter officers (see below) for assistance in the review process."

Faculty membership is \$115 (\$95.00 for yearly dues and a one-time initiation fee of \$20.00) and graduate student membership is \$45 (\$25.00 for yearly dues and a one-time initiation fee of \$20.00). Life experience is also considered in some instances. Please note that some chapters have additional requirements for full membership. - Professional Positions: Institution(s), date(s), position title(s)
- Publications: Titles, authors, dates, source(s) (journal name, thesis, etc.)

Associate membership is offered to encourage young investigators with promise to continue careers in research. For nomination to Associate Membership, attach a brief statement regarding the nominee's involvement in research and potential research aptitude.

<u>Promotion to Full Membership</u> is conferred upon any individual who, previously elected as an Associate Member, now meets the requirements for Full Membership as stated above. For promotion to Full Membership, either attach a CV or résumé OR provide a separate attachment with the information listed under Full Membership above.
