

- 5. Summary of Program Goals and Objectives and Progress at Meeting Them

In fall 2014, IBHE approved the reasonable and moderate extension of the BSED in Middle Level Education. At that time, the program had four majors. The number of MLE majors has increased, as demonstrated in the table, and should maintain growth in the future as teaching becomes more attractive to undergraduate students.



The program has had one completer, representing a 100% pass rate on both content tests and edTPA testing requirements. After spring 2018, seven additional students will complete the approved program. These seven also represent a 100% pass rate on content tests, but results are not yet in for the edTPA component.

The teacher candidates are performing well in their practicum placements and are being recruited from around the state. As the teacher shortage continues, job prospects for these majors continues to be strong.
