Transfer Agreement

between City Colleges of Chicago and Eastern Illinois University

The purpose of this agreement is to solidify a relationship between CCC and EIU wherein both institutions commit to ensuring clarity and collaboration in the transfer process. Specifically, as part of this agreement, EIU, as stated in its undergraduate catalog, commits to accepting in its entirety an A.A., A.S., or A.A.T (Math, Early Childhood, or Special Education) degree earned at any of the seven City Colleges of Chicago. As such, CCC students who are admitted to EIU and who have completed an A.A., A.S., or A.A.T. (Math, Early Childhood, or Special Education), degree will be guaranteed junior status and will be considered to have completed all general education requirements.

The following language specifies the Transfer Policies in EIU's Undergraduate Catalog:

EIU Admissions Terms:

1. Students who have completed an A.A., A.S. or A.A.T. (Math, Early Childhood, or Special Education) from CCC will be considered to have met the EIU General Education requirements.
2. Students who have completed an A.A., A.S. or A.A.T. (Math, Early Childhood, or Special Education) will be guaranteed junior class standing.
3. Students who have completed an A.A., A.S. or A.A.T. (Math, Early Childhood, or Special Education) will have their cultural diversity requirements automatically waived.
4. Throughout the transfer and application process, students who have any questions or problems with the transfer of their credits from CCC to EIU will be assisted by the administrator, or her/his designee, EIU's Office of Transfer Relations. This office will assist the student and seek to ensure that the terms and intent of this agreement are met.
