Notes

- Courses taken at the Community College will not be used toward upper division requirements. 40 semester hours of upper division credit is required for a Bachelor's Degree. These courses are to be taken at the senior level institution.
- An audition required for admission to the BA in Music – Audio Recording Technology Concentration. Recommend applied study course to prepare for an audition.
- Apply to Eastern and have official transcripts sent from high school and college.
- Forty (40) semester hours of upper division credit is required for a bachelor's degree and courses are to be taken at the senior level institution. Six upper division credits may be waived to help meet this requirement.
- Students may elect to take up to 12 credits of MUS 4275. While only 6 credits are required, additional credits will help meet the upper division credit requirement.
- Foreign Language is a graduation requirement. Two full years of high school foreign language with a "C" average or completion of the second semester of a college foreign language will satisfy this requirement.
- As a requirement for graduation, at least 66 credits must be non-music. Recommend a minor in Digital Media or Radio/TV Production.

¹ This requirement may be fulfilled through multiple options at ECC. Recommend MUS 126/127 (EIU MUS 2203/04), MUS 140/240 (EIU MUS 11__ Applied Music/Private Lessons), or ensemble (EIU MUS 02__ Music Ensembles). Two credits of Private Lessons or Ensemble could be fulfilled through the 2 credits of Applied Music taken at ECC.

² A "C" or better is required in English, Speech, Math (Algebra or higher) and all courses for the major.

³ Apply to Eastern and have official transcripts sent from high school and college

⁴ One science course must have a lab component. A total of 7 hours in sciences is required.

⁵ MUS 146 Rock and Roll Music Appreciation taken at Elgin can fulfill the EIU requirement for MUS 2557G – Evolution of Jazz Rock. Course would be equated on an individual basis for transferring students.

⁶ Transfer students with 29 or fewer hours must complete MUS 1103 (4) times; 30-59 transfer hours must complete MUS 1103 (3) times; 60 or more transfer hours must complete MUS 1103 (2) times.

⁷ If needed. Pre-requisite –Successful completion of placement exam.

Articulation Agreement
Between
Eastern Illinois University
And
Elgin Community College

Elgin Community College (ECC) and the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University (EIU) form a cooperative relationship through this articulation agreement to serve better our public constituents, to smooth transfer, to minimize duplication of instruction, and to build on community college and university learning experiences. Both institutions recognize that working together, their collective efforts are stronger than their individual efforts.


The two institutions agree to the following:

1. Any student who has completed a transferable associate in arts, associate in science or associate in science and arts degree at ECC consistent with the Illinois Articulation Initiative (with the required 2.00 GPA) and submits required application and supporting documentation will automatically be admitted to EIU at the junior level and will be deemed to have met EIU's lower division general education requirement.
2. Acceptance into a specific EIU program is based on the individual transferring student meeting the conditions and considerations listed for that program. Specifically, students completing the **Music Production A.F.A.** at ECC will be admitted to the baccalaureate **Music, Audio Recording Technology Concentration B.A.** at EIU.
3. The courses listed in the attached prescribed ECC transfer guide has been reviewed and accepted for transfer to EIU.
4. Relationships between ECC and EIU faculty and administration are in the spirit of cooperation and provide the basis for this agreement
5. Representatives of both institutions agree to meet on a regular basis to assess curricular changes and other conditions that may affect the nature of this agreement.
6. This agreement does not preclude either institution from making curriculum changes as it may solely deem appropriate in which case appropriate prior notice will be given to the operative academic personnel at the cooperating institution.
7. Appropriate publications and promotional materials regarding this agreement will be made available to all ECC students.
8. Either EIU or ECC may dissolve this agreement by giving one years' advance notice to the cooperating institution's president or academic vice president.
9. This agreement is effective with the **2023-2024** academic year and is subject to renewal quadrennially.


