LAPTOP COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

STUDENTS ENTERING FALL 2017

A personal computer is and will continue to be an important part of the educational experience. A student will need to have access to personal computer technologies as he or she moves through his or her educational experience at Eastern Illinois University. In some cases the personal computer may not be used in class but will be required to complete class assignments; in other instances the personal computer will be an integral part of the classroom experience.

All entering art majors are required to have an Apple laptop computer. The hardware requirements are subject to change each year as Apple develops and markets new laptop models. To provide you with a sense of the requirements the following were the Fall 2016 hardware requirements:

For all Art majors the recommended minimum configured laptop is the MacBook Pro 15-inch with 2.2GHz quad-core Intel Core i7, processor (Turbo Boost up to 3.4GHz) with 6MB shared L3 cache, 256 GB PCIe-based flash storage.

The above is the recommended minimum laptop requirement; if you are able to purchase an Apple laptop with greater processor speed, memory and screen size and/or quality, then consider selecting that laptop. The department also recommends that all students purchase: (1) a 4GB or larger flash drive for backup and easy transport of files; (2) carrying case or laptop backpack; (3) the extended warranty; and (4) either an external hard drive for backup or a remote backup service.

Software requirements are:

Microsoft Office (student edition) and the Adobe Creative Cloud Design Standard (education version) (www.adobe.com). Adobe Creative Cloud Design Standard Collection is strongly recommended for students interested in the Graphic Design option. Students accepted into the Graphic Design program beginning their junior year would be expected to subscribe to the Adobe Creative Cloud (education version) at that time.

Before you purchase your computer and software for your college career, you should check the pricing available for computer and software bundles through the EIU Bookstore. Very reasonable pricing for software is often available. FOOTNOTES:

+Minimum Grade for Teacher Licensure Program – Effective February 1, 2012, the Illinois State Board of Education will no longer allow any grade lower than a “C” to be used in a teacher certification program. All students graduating after December 2011 with a teacher certification major must earn a grade of “C” or better in all courses, regardless where they are taken, used toward graduation. This includes general education, professional education, major and minor courses, all university required courses, and electives. Furthermore, any course used for the purpose of adding endorsements to a teaching certificate must be completed with a grade of “C” or better.

¹Requires University Approval to Take Teacher Education Courses

²Teacher Licensure candidates are required to take a 3-semester hour diversity course or third world/non-western culture course.

EDF 2555G – Education in a Diverse Society will fulfill the requirement.

³GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR FOREIGN LANGUAGE (0-8 HOURS)

The graduation requirement is successful completion of two courses in a single foreign language. Exemption: Students entering university FALL 93 and after must have completed two (2) years in a single Foreign Language in High School with a grade of “C” or better to have satisfied this requirement.

⁴The nine semester hours of art electives in a selected art medium should be taken from coursework in ceramics, drawing and painting, graphic design/electronic media, jewelry/metalsmithing, printmaking, or sculpture.

⁵For students in the Art Education Option, the University Approval to Take Teacher Education Courses should occur no later than the first semester of the Junior year.

⁶Students may enroll in any undergraduate professional education course that includes a field experience or practicum no more than twice.

⁷Credits count for both Teacher Licensure option and General Education Fine Arts requirements.

⁸Credits count for both Teacher Licensure option and General Education Social/Behavior Science requirement.
