The estate of Ruth C. Boyd Cook provided the funding to establish the award in 1992. Ruth enjoyed painting and the award is given to the best students who have completed one year in the Department of Art in the field of painting. The painting faculty nominates the students. The award shall be given to the best student or students who have completed at least one (1) year in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences in the field of painting. The award shall be based on excellence only and shall in no way be based on need.

Paul Turner Sargent Scholarship

While not the largest of the monetary awards – it is the oldest and one of the most distinguished departmental awards. Paul Sargent was a 1906 graduate of Eastern Illinois University and went on to study and graduate from the Art Institute of Chicago and became regionally recognized as a landscape painter and was associated with the Brown Country Art Colony of Indiana.

The award is presented to an art major or minor who has 40 semester hours of academic credit, at least 24 hours completed at EIU. The candidate must demonstrate outstanding aptitudes in art and a sincere interest in art and art education. This award is selected by the faculty of the Department of Art.

Irene Couchman Buzzard Scholarship

Irene Couchman Buzzard was the wife of Dr. Robert G. Buzzard, the third President of Eastern Illinois University from 1933 to 1956 and had an interest in the textile arts. Ms. Martha Feutz established the scholarship in 1997, in her memory and interest in the fine arts crafts and textile arts.

The recipient must be a full-time student majoring in Art with Sophomore standing or above, and with a minimum overall GPA of 2.50, and an Art GPA of 3.0. The recipient shall be eligible to apply for, and receive, the award one additional time provided she/he continues to meet the criteria stated above. The award shall be issued in the Spring Semester. The Department of Art faculty nominates students and preference will be given to students demonstrating an excellence in fine art crafts (ceramics, textile arts, jewelry/metalsmithing). Both undergraduate and graduate students are eligible.

June Krutza Art Scholarship




The Melinda Clancy Hegarty Memorial Travel Fund Award


