Entrance into the Junior (3rd) year of the program is determined by the Graphic Design Selective Admissions Committee. Admission to the program is limited to those students who have satisfied the specific course requirements (ART 1000, 1001, 1110, 1111, 2500, 2050 OR 2560, 2910, 2920) (six semester hours ART 2012, 2601, or 2602) and (ENG 1001G and 1002G), have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.25 for all coursework, and a minimum GPA of 2.75 for all Art coursework, and submit an art and design portfolio. The art and design portfolio will be reviewed by the Graphic Design Selective Admissions Committee. Admission into the program is based on a comparative scoring system of performance in the above requirements (cumulative GPA, Art GPA, completion of required coursework, art and design portfolio).

LAPTOP COMPUTER REQUIREMENTS

STUDENTS ENTERING FALL 2016

A personal computer is and will continue to be an important part of the educational experience. A student will need to have access to personal computer technologies as he or she moves through his or her educational experience at Eastern Illinois University. In some cases the personal computer may not be used in class but will be required to complete class assignments; in other instances the personal computer will be an integral part of the classroom experience.

All entering art majors are required to have an Apple laptop computer. The hardware requirements are subject to change each year as Apple develops and markets new laptop models. To provide you with a sense of the requirements the following were the Fall 2015 hardware requirements:

For all Art majors the recommended minimum configured laptop is the MacBook Pro 15-inch with 2.5GHz quad-core Intel Core i7, 16 GB memory, 512GB PCIe-based Flash Storage, Intel Iris Pro Graphics, NVIDIA GeForce GT 750M with 2GB GDDR5 memory.

The above is the recommended minimum laptop requirement; if you are able to purchase an Apple laptop with greater processor speed, memory and screen size and/or quality, then consider selecting that laptop. The department also recommends that all students purchase: (1) a 4GB or larger flash drive for backup and easy transport of files; (2) carrying case or laptop backpack; (3) the extended warranty; and (4) either an external hard drive for backup or a remote backup service.

Software requirements are:

Microsoft Office (student edition) and the Adobe Creative Cloud Design Standard (education version) (www.adobe.com). Adobe Creative Cloud Design Standard Collection is strongly recommended for students interested in the Graphic Design option. Students accepted into the Graphic Design program beginning their junior year would be expected to subscribe to the Adobe Creative Cloud (education version) at that time.

Before you purchase your computer and software for your college career, you should check the pricing available for computer and software bundles through the EIU Bookstore. Very reasonable pricing for software is often available. ¹To be taken during freshman and sophomore years to meet Graphic Design Selective Admissions course requirements.

²Must be admitted to Graphic Design program in Junior (3rd) year to enroll in these classes.

³GRADUATION REQUIREMENT FOR FOREIGN LANGUAGE (0-8 HOURS) The graduation requirement is successful completion of two courses in a single foreign language. Exemption: Students entering university FALL 93 and after must have completed two (2) years in a single Foreign Language in High School with a grade of "C" or better to have satisfied this requirement. Students exempt from Foreign Language would have 6 semester hours of free electives to complete for degree requirements.

⁴Students are required to complete a course with a focus on cultural diversity. Students can take one of several designated general education courses: see Gen. Ed. courses Listed by Segment in the Gen. Ed. section of the Undergraduate Catalog.

⁵Select 6 semester hours of electives chosen from Applied Engineering & Technology (AET) 2123, 3343, 4353, 4813, Communications Studies (CMN) 3540, 4500, 4540, Journalism (JOU) 2950, 3001, English (ENG) 4760, Art studio or Art History courses.

⁶Art 4749 is an audit only class with no credit earned; taken concurrently with Art 4920 or Art 4921 or Art 4922.

⁷Credits count for both Graphic Design option and General Education Fine Arts requirements.
