JOHN KELSO (Mother Burnside and Babcock) is a Mid-westerner who might consider Sullivan his second home. A veteran of 13 years of The Little Theatre-On The Square, John was featured last season in CAMELOT, APPLAUSE, WAIT UNTIL DARK and BLITHE SPIRIT. This year he appeared in LOVERS AND OTHER STRANGERS, ONE FLEW OVER THE CUCKOO'S NEST, and SUGAR.

DAVID ARTHUR (Patrick Dennis, age 19-29) first appeared in Sullivan in THE UNSINKABLE MOLLY BROWN with Barbara Rush, and subsequently appeared in ANYTHING GOES with Frank Sutton, and FIDDLER ON THE ROOF with Shelly Berman. A DePaul University graduate, Mr. Arthur has appeared in leading theatres in the country in CHILD'S PLAY, THERE'S A GRIL IN MY SOUP with Van Johnson and again with Robert Horton. He also has appeared in APPLAUSE with Rosemary Prinz, and ON A CLEAR DAY with Harv Presnell.

DENNIS GRIMALDI (M. Lindsay Woolsey, Uncle Jeff) recently toured in A SONG FOR CYRANO with Jose Ferrar, and the National Company of PROMISES, PROMISES. He spent two seasons at the Milwaukee Melody Top appearing in productions of FIDDLER ON THE ROOF and HELLO, DOLLY! Four seasons ago, he appeared in Sullivan in DO I HEAR A WALTZ? with Patricia Morison, GEORGE M! with Bill Hayes, and appeared in the American premiere of A FLEA IN HER EAR with Hiram Sherman. Last spring, he served as assistant to choreographer George Bunt at the Cincinnati Playhouse in the Park, an assignment which he is repeating in Sullivan this year. Mr. Grimaldi appeared as "Spats" in the recent production of SUGAR.

ANNA MCNEELY (Dance Teacher, Madame Branislawski, Cousin Fan, Mrs. Upson) made her first professional stage appearance at The Little Theatre-On The Square in COMPANY with Janis Paige. A former apprentice in Sullivan, Miss McNeely has sung in many of the musicals for the past four seasons and won the part of Ernestina in the 1971 production of HELLO, DOLLY!

STEVE VUJOVIC (Stage Manager, Mr. Upson) appeared as JoJo in IRMA LA DOUCE with Lesley Warren, Rocky in DAMN YANKEES with Gary Collins, Vogle in BLOSSOM TIME with Allan Jones, and the TV Director in APPLAUSE with Rosemary Prinz during the 1973 season. During the current season, Mr. Vujovic's credits include the American Tribal Love-Rock Musical, HAIR, and SUGAR.

MICHAEL KARM (Director). Mr. Karm's active career has involved him as both actor and director. He has directed Ruta Lee in PETERPAT for the Windmill Dinner Theatres, BUTTERFLIES ARE FREE, and COME BLOW YOUR HORN for Tiffany's Attic Dinner Theatre, and Ruth Wolff's ARABIC-TWO off-Broadway at the New Theatre. Michael created the role of "Ham" in Danny Kaye's TWO BY TWO. He has filmed a leading role in a soon to be released comedy, HEY, YOU'LL NEVER MISS IT.

He has appeared off-Broadway in SALVATION, THE MAD SHOW, and BEST FOOT FORWARD, the revival that first showcased Liza Minnelli to New York audiences. He has been featured in summer tours of LUV, MILK AND HONEY, and MR. ROBERTS. He has also appeared in revivals of SOUTH PACIFIC at Lincoln and City Centers.

DOROTHY OPALACH (Musical Director), is making her debut at The Little Theatre-On The Square and has conducted most of the major musical theatre works in Atlanta Municipal Theatre, bus and truck tours and summer stock. She has just returned from almost a year of touring with the first production of Stephen Sondheim's "FOLLIES". A native New Yorker, Miss Opalach maintains a very successful studio where she teaches voice and coaches repertoire.

ROSEMARY PRINZ (Mame)...The Little Theatre-On The Square's most popular star, returns to Sullivan for her 12th production! Miss Prinz became a national byword in American homes while she appeared as Penny on AS THE WORLD TURNS for over a decade, and later initiated the successful and popular ALL MY CHILDREN and currently is starred on the new NBC series, HOW TO SURVIVE A MARRIAGE. Since her Sullivan debut as Jennifer in PAINT YOUR WAGON in 1961, Rosemary has returned to central Illinois as the star of THE UNSINKABLE MOLLY BROWN in 1963, KIND SIR in 1964, MARY, MARY in 1965, LULLABY in 1966, A GIRL COULD GET LUCKY in 1967, ANNIE GET YOUR GUN in 1969, I DO! I DO!, 13 RUE DEL'AMOUR and LAST OF THE RED HOT LOVERS in 1972, and last season, APPLAUSE. She has established many box office records for the Sullivan theatre and is the only star to have opened three seasons, and the only star to make three appearances in one season!

Rosemary made her stage debut at the age of sixteen and found her "first love"...the theatre. Although she made it to Broadway in record time to appear with Arlene Francis in LATE LOVE and Louis Jourdan in TONIGHT IN SAMARKAND, she spent several years before, performing in summer theatres throughout the country. In recent years, she has starred in the Broadway and National tour of THE PRISONER OF SECOND AVENUE with Art Carney, as well as the all-star cast revival of THREE MEN ON A HORSE. In addition, Rosemary toured cross-country in THE APPLE TREE and LAST OF THE RED HOT LOVERS. JANE BERGERE (Gooch) won the New York regional competition of the Metropolitan Opera at the tender age of 15, but her love of acting led her from opera to musical comedy where her roles included Louise in GYPSY, Maria in WEST SIDE STORY, Sarah Brown in GUYS AND DOLLS, Magnolia in SHOWBOAT, standby for Carol Lawrence as Julie in CAROUSEL, Tupin in THE KING AND I, and the title role in CARMEN. She began as the ghost, Grandma Tzeitel, in the Broadway company of FIDDLER ON THE ROOF...and ended up in the same show playing the lovely young daughter, Hodel, with Jan Pierce. Jane has performed a comedy act under the name of Agnes Grouch at the Continental Baths in New York, and on the Tonight Show...In Long Island, New York, she astonished viewers by changing on camera in a brief ten seconds from an old lady into a glamorous young ingenue, singing all the while in three different voices.

She frequently has to leave her 19th Avenue apartment dressed to perform as Agnes Grouch, much to the confusion of her doorman, her

husband, her 18 month old daughter and her maltese dog, Tuptin, who barks a lot.

PAMELA DANSER (Vera), at nineteen won a full voice Fellowship to the Juilliard School of Music in New York, appeared briefly in concert and opera, then forsook the limelight to raise her five children. When her youngest child entered kindergarten, she reappeared at Springfield's Community Theatre as Anna in THE KING AND I. The following four years led her "back to the footlights" with leading roles for four years at the Cooperstown Playhouse in New York, then five years as principal player at Shady Lane Playhouse in Marengo, and appearances at Chicago's Ivanhoe and Minnesota's Old Log Playhouse.

Miss Danser's Sullivan roles include Bellabruna in last season's BLOSSOM TIME with Alan Jones, Nettie in CAROUSEL with Peter Palmer, Meg in DAMN YANKEES with Gary Collins, John Payne's leading lady in TIMID TIGER and MY THREE ANGELS with Andy Devine.

FRANK MILLER (Beaugard) returns to the Little Theatre-On The Square after playing in THE GAZEBO in Kansas City. He will be remembered as Chief Bromden in ONE FLEW OVER THE CUCKOO'S NEST with Leonard Nimoy earlier this season. JOEY PATTON (Ito)...this is Mr. Patton's second adventure with Auntie Mame. Years ago, he was younger Patrick and Gypsy Rose Lee portrayed his legendary Aunt. Joey's stage career began at age four in LIFE WITH MOTHER starring Billie Burke. A few years later, he was one of Walt Disney's MOUSEKETEERS.

As a taller person, some of his favorite roles include the M.C. in CABARET, Will Parker in OKLAHOMA! and Kipps in HALF A SIXPENCE. Last season Joey portrayed Duane in APPLAUSE, here on the Square, starring Rosemary Prinz. This role came quite naturally, because he's been her personal hairstylist for the past six years. Now, he is working with her on the NBC show, HOW TO SURVIVE A MARRIAGE and backstage, provides our MAME with her constant changes of hair color.

Joey's latest projects include re-decorating Rosemary Prinz's and Joe Patti's apartment in New York City; writing a book titled THE STARVING ACTOR'S COOKBOOK (to be published summer - 75) and appearing wearing only a sheepish grin, in an upcoming issue of Playgirl Magazine.

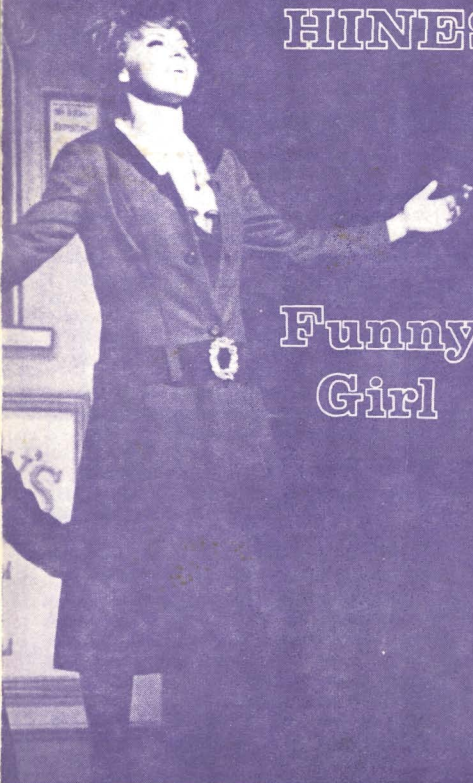
