A. Dr. Stephen Lucas and Dr. Rebecca Throneburg attended to provide an update on the draft EIU Learning Goals and responded to questions from the committee. Dr. Lucas thanked the committee for their help last year with the development of the Quantitative Reasoning Learning Goal. Dr. Throneburg discussed the process of revising the University Learning Goals to this point. Dr. Lucas discussed the Five-Year Plan, and upcoming policy revisions that will be coming before CAA such as the syllabus policy, the credit hour policy and the revised course proposal. They explained that they anticipate approval of the revised learning goals this semester, likely at the meeting held the last week of instruction. They plan to hold workshops for faculty on the new learning goals next semester. In the future they want to look at what goes on inside the general education classes. They see those classes as serving to lay the foundation for the learning goals and will be looking for those classes to provide depth in one or two of the categories. CAA also wants to look at what assessment can be done during the middle college years and how the learning goals are tied into the capstone and upper division courses offered in the majors. They thanked the committee and said they anticipated returning each semester during the implementation of their five-year plan.
