Dean Hendrickson:

The Department of Public Health & Nutrition would like to request the following by executive action:

NTR 4758: Add the following to the course description: NTR 4758 can be repeated after NTR 4757 for credit and a grade recalculation.

Rationale: 4758 has replaced 4757 in the curriculum. Students who previously took 4757 and earned a grade of D now have to take 4758 to earn the required grade of "C". Adding this statement will allow them to also use their grade in 4758 for grade recalculation, just as they would formerly have been able to if they repeated 4757.
